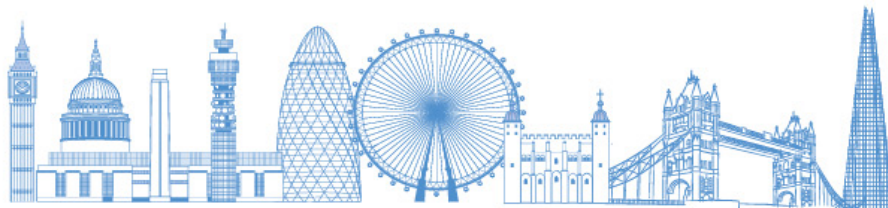

Tuition fees

We have classified you as an overseas student for the purpose of fees based on your application.

Tuition fees for the 2017/8 academic session for this course will be **£14,500**.

In accordance with the Student Terms and Conditions, which can be found [click here](#), in accepting this offer you confirm that you are aware of our ability to increase tuition fees in line with inflation (RPI). Increases in tuition fees will only ever happen at the start of an academic year and students will be notified in advance.

Applying for a student visa

If you require a Tier 4 Visa, you will need to:

- Receive and accept our unconditional offer on [UKPASS](#).
- Pay the minimum £4,000 deposit on the [applicant portal](#).

Once you have completed the above we will invite you to request your [Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies \(CAS\)](#) on the [applicant portal](#). The CAS is a unique reference number which [UK Visas and Immigration \(UKVI\)](#) need for your visa application form. The CAS confirms that the University of Westminster is sponsoring your visa for this course.

The University will include the tuition fee you have paid on your CAS. You can make additional payments but the CAS will not be automatically updated. To ensure that you have the correct information on your visa application, please email [Tier 4 Visas](#) to let us know about the additional payment(s) before you submit the visa application, we will then send you an updated CAS.

Applying for a student visa can be a complicated process and our [student advice service](#) can offer helpful information about making a successful [Tier 4 Visa application](#), including information on the financial [28 day maintenance requirement](#). If your visa application is refused, you will be eligible for a full deposit refund if a copy of the visa refusal letter is sent to [Tier 4 Visas](#).
